## 'Accelerating Action' for Black Women

Our International Women's Day conference held in London was a sold-out success. The theme of IWD25 was 'Accelerate Action' and we certainly did that! Sponsored by Voice4Change-England, the event was packed with speakers, panels, workshops, a marketplace that offered a true shopping experience and 1:1 business support the event was a smorgasbord of Black excellence.

We were blessed to have four awesome Keynote speakers: Ngozi Cadmus spoke about the importance of Rest in the life cycle of Black women, reminding us all of the relevance of Rest in pursuit of health and resistance.

Professor Dr Nira Chamberlain OBE took the conference on a mathematical journey, in his talk "If All Things Were Equal". Diana Chrouch OBE reminded the conference of the role that Black women have played in advancing Black feminism from the USA to the UK. Roz Etwaria delivered a powerful talk on Misogynoir, highlighting the disparity between white feminism and Black feminist principles.

Four truly empowering workshops on Finance, Health & Wellbeing, Personal "The energy was Development and Social Enterprise were well attended. amazing, powerful keynotes, great panel discussions, and meaningful interactions at the stalls." # A National Commission on Black Women & Girls

Conference agreed that the next step to accelerate action, was to follow-up on our call-toaction for a National Commission on Black Women & Girls. A plenary panel chaired by Roz Etwaria, consisted of wide-ranging voices of experience across a range of disciplines and included DEI Strategist Grace Mosuro, former CIH President, Lara Oyedele; newly appointed ROTA CEO and former Runneymede Trust Researcher Matthew Johnson, Midwife and Founder of Elite Midwifery Services, Diana Chrouch OBE, a Special Adviser to the APPG Ethnic Minority Businesses and Soul Purpose 360 CEO Palma Black.

#### The Need for a National Commission

Black women and girls in Britain face multifaceted challenges that intersect across various aspects of life, including healthcare, housing, education, economic opportunity and social justice. Despite their significant contributions to society, they continue to experience systemic barriers that hinder their full potential. Soul Purpose 360 believes that a National Commission dedicated to Black women and girls is crucial to driving policy changes and initiatives that address these issues at both national and community levels. We are urging policymakers, community leaders, Black women's organisations, trade unions, VCSE's and ordinary citizens to support the establishment of this National Commission. By coming together, we can create a framework that not only addresses the immediate needs of Black women and girls but also lays the groundwork for long-term systemic change. Together, we can ensure a future where Black women and girls thrive and lead with confidence and dignity. Further information is available on our website.


#### Help us to reach, engage and empower more Black women by promoting the members benefits
